Thanks for your reply! Our goal is to have our video completed by March 2017. In order to meet that goal, we would need to get the interview with Governor Haley sometime in the month of October at her earliest convenience. We are located right here on the Capitol Complex and would be available at any time to walk over for a quick interview (30 minutes max including setup).

The purpose of the video is to highlight successes in landscape scale conservation through mitigation in working with industry. The questions we plan to ask Governor Haley are listed below. We have already interviewed Secretary Hitt, Lt. Col. Luzzatto of the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers and have interviews scheduled with Leah Crider of Boeing and David Thomas of Haile Gold Mine.

The video will be utilized in a variety of platforms through the SCDNR website, social media outlets and will also be an online complimentary piece to an article being released in the SC Wildlife Magazine in the upcoming March-April issue. As we finalize the video, we may also pursue ETV documentary airtime to highlight the benefits of industry and the conservation community working together protecting the gorgeous resources of our state that often assist in attracting these businesses.
