Mr. Poore called the meeting to order and Councilman Fred H. Bratcher gave the invocation.

On the motion of Mr. Kinley, seconded by Mr. Rhodes, Council voted unanimously to approve the minutes from the February 2, 1982 minutes as mailed.

Ms. Gale Hunter asked Council to approve Ordinance #77 Bel-Path Cable TV franchise. On the motion of Mr. Hooper, seconded by Mr. Kinley, Council voted unanimously to approve on first reading the above ordinance.

Mr. Joe Blake asked Council to approve an ordinance (#79 - Orian Rugs) for the issuance of \$3 Million Industrial Revenue Bonds. Mr. Kenyon presented the ordinance for first reading. On the motion of Mr. Rhodes, seconded by Mr. Kinley, Council voted four (4) in favor, Mr. Wright abstained, (see attached) to approve Ordinance #79 on first reading. Mr. Kenyon presented the Petition and Resolution #143 to the State Budget and Control Board for Orian Rugs. On the motion of Mr. Kinley, seconded by Mr. Hooper, Council voted four (4) in favor to adopt the petition and resolution. Mr. Wright abstained. (see attached)

Mr. David Brissey, a resident of Gilmer Estates, presented a petition signed by all the residents asking for the road to be paved. Mr. Poore explained that he would do his best until the new budget is adopted and then he would asphalt Gilmer Estates. Mr. Kinley also promised that these roads would be paved in the spring.

Mr. Carl Stone asked that Council transfer \$15,000 from Code 12 to Code 79. On the motion of Mr. Bratcher, seconded by Mr. Rhodes, Council voted unanimously to approve the transfer.

Mr. Hooper discussed vacancies on the S.C. Appalachian Council of Governments' Board. He recommended that Mr. Alphonso Norris and Mr. Joe Davenport be reappointed, and that Curtis Kinley replace Dan Rhodes who had asked to be replaced. On the motion of Mr. Hooper, seconded by Mr. Rhodes, Council voted unanimously to fill the vacancies as recommended.

Mr. David Crenshaw discussed the large recorder at the County Jail. He stated that it is beyond economical repair. To replace the equipment it would cost \$14,029. On the motion of Mr. Hooper, seconded by Mr. Bratcher, Council voted unanimously to allow the purchase.

Mr. Rhodes presented second reading of Ordinance #73 - Crime Watch Signs as amended. On the motion of Mr. Rhodes, seconded by Mr. Kinley, Council voted unanimously to adopt on second reading.

Mr. Watson presented a request from the Election Commission that \$450.00 be transferred from accounts within the Election Commission's budget. On the motion of Mr. Wright, seconded by Mr. Rhodes, Council voted unanimously to allow the transfer.

Council directed the clerk to contact Mr. Bill Gaston and Mr. Laniel Chapman and ask them to be present at the March 2, 1982 meeting for discussion of the vote recorder.

Mr. Watson presented a request from Jean Taylor with PATH asking that they receive the balance of their 1981-82 appropriation. Due to inflation they have been unable to meet their budget. On the motion of Mr. Hooper, seconded by Mr. Wright, Council voted four in favor with one opposed. Motion passed by majority vote. Mr. Kinley voted against the motion.

Mr. Watson presented a proposal for Council's consideration for amendments to the 1981-82 fy budget. Mr. Hooper stated he did not agree with certain sections of the proposal and stated that he had a proposal to present to County Council. (see attached)

Mr. Hooper's motion was seconded by Mr. Rhodes, vote was three in favor and two opposed. Mr. Wright & Mr. Bratcher opposed the motion. Mr. Poore called for a vote on the original proposal. Mr. Bratcher moved to adopt, Mr. Wright seconded. Vote was 2 in favor - 3 opposed.

Mr. Kenyon presented Ordinance #80 - County Code. On the motion of Mr. Hooper, seconded by Mr. Kinley, Council voted three to two to adopt on first reading and to include in the 1982-83 fy budget. Mr. Wright abstained (see attached) and Mr. Bratcher opposed.

Mr. Kenyon presented Ordinance #78 - Reapportionment for Anderson County. On the motion of Mr. Rhodes, seconded by Mr. Kinley, Council voted three to two to adopt Ordinance #78. Mr. Wright voted against the motion. Mr. Bratcher abstained.

On the motion of Mr. Rhodes, seconded by Mr. Hooper, Council voted unanimously to have a called meeting at 9:00, Friday, February 19, 1982 to allow for second reading of Ordinance #80 (County Code) and Ordinance #78 (Reapportionment).

Mr. Keaton discussed the need to repair Breazeale road. Mr. Poore promised to put crushed stone until they can do better.

On the motion of Mr. Hooper, seconded by Mr. Rhodes, Council voted unanimously to direct the purchasing agent to send copies of all budget request forms to them as they are received in his office.

On the motion of Mr. Hooper, seconded by Mr. Wright, Council voted unanimously to adjourn at 8:30 p.m.
