Subject: President Obama's Weekly Address: The 21st Century Cures Act

In this week's address, [President Obama highlights the 21st Century Cures Act](#), a bill in Congress that could help us find a cure for Alzheimer's, end cancer as we know it, and help those who are seeking treatment for opioid addiction. This week, the House passed the bill overwhelmingly with bipartisan support - and the President called on the Senate to do the same when they vote in a few days. "For nearly a year, I've been calling for this investment so hundreds of thousands of Americans can get the treatment they need," said President Obama, "I'm glad Congress is finally getting it done."
