Chaney,

In the floor debate on the roads bill today, Rep. Jonathan Hill criticized Gov. Haley.

Hill cited comments that Gov. Haley made during a June 2014 appearance at the First Monday Club of Anderson in which he said she voiced support for eliminating the DOT commission and opposed a gas tax increase. He even emailed a sound-cloud recording from that day in which the governor talked about road funding, saying "We don't need to raise taxes to do it...the money is there."

Hill said today that the governor changed her position and called for a gas tax increase after being re-elected and now apparently does not support elimination of the DOT commission.

"Gov. Haley, in Anderson that is what we call being a hypocrite," Hill said on the floor of the House.
