I can see the causeway from my house and have seen rangers moving about, but they are probably handling downed trees, removing washed up debris from roads and walks, and dealing with everything else. Pawleys Island, just south of the park, is removing 3-4 FEET of sand from their roads. The park will reopen as soon as they can and only after endless, exhausting work to get it ready.
