Frank,

Would you mind scoring two "what-if" scenarios for us please? It may well be the same answer for both questions, but could you please provide separate scoring letters?

The question is, what would the gas tax have to be (on a cents-per-gallon basis) in order to generate \$X of new revenue for transportation on an annual basis? "Annual" in this case would be next year, however it would be easiest for you to define that...CY15, FY 2015-16, etc. I'm guessing CY15. The two values for X would be \$1.45 billion and \$1.47 billion. I'm not looking for long-term projections in this case...just what it would take next year to generate that much more money.

If at all possible, could we get this by Monday or Tuesday? Thanks.
