> S.C. Army National Guard UH-60 Black Hawk recovery operation begins

> COLUMBIA, SC – The S.C. Army National Guard UH-60 Black Hawk that made the emergency landing due to a main rotor blade malfunction Dec. 3 along interstate 77 near exit 2, has been released by the Accident Investigation Board and will be moved to McEntire Joint National Guard Base, Eastover, S.C. tomorrow.
>
> The S.C. Army National Guard will begin recovery operations at approximately 8 a.m. when safety and maintenance crews will prepare the helicopter for transport via sling-load under a S.C. Army National Guard CH-47 Chinook helicopter. The public can expect to see an increase in ground activity at the accident site throughout the morning with air operations expected to begin after 1 p.m. If weather and conditions permit, the sling-load and transport should be complete by 3 p.m.
>
> The CH-47 that will carry the Black Hawk will be accompanied by a UH-72 Lakota. Both helicopters will be flying in from the S.C. Army National Guard Army Aviation Support Facility in Greenville, S.C.

> The Black Hawk is assigned to Detachment 2, Company F, 1-171st General Support Aviation Battalion. The Chinook is assigned to Detachment 1, B-Company, 2-238th General Support Aviation Battalion. The Lakota is assigned to A Company, 2-151st Security and Support Aviation Battalion.

>

> For safety reasons, access to the area will remain restricted until recovery operations are complete. The S.C. National Guard appreciates the assistance from first responders and is grateful for the community's outpouring of support for the skilled pilots who safely landed the aircraft.
