RE: Resurfacing of Brewer Springs Road in Kershaw County

Dear Mr. Arrants:

Thank you for your email to Governor Haley regarding the condition of pavement on Brewer Spring Road in Camden. Governor Haley requested that the South Carolina Department of Transportation (SCDOT) review your concerns and respond accordingly. District Engineering staff has investigated your request and a report is provided below.

The resurfacing of Brewer Springs Road was contracted out by SCDOT to C. R. Jackson, a local paving contractor. The resurfacing work on this road was completed in June 2015. From initial investigation, it appears that the location where the pot hole is forming was a high area in the roadway and the full thickness of asphalt was not achieved at this location. The contractor recently patched this area as a temporary measure. The permanent repair plan includes cutting cores in the asphalt at this location to determine the current thickness of the newly placed asphalt. The areas that do not have the required thickness will be milled out and the full thickness of asphalt will be placed. This repair will ensure that future pot holes do not form at this location.
