Bid Date Set For Low-Cost Housing Work

Bids on the construction of the \$1,000,000 Gonzales Gardens, white low cost housing project to be erected across Forest Drive from the Providence hospital, have been called for by the Columbia housing authority.

The bids will be received by the authority at the office of Arthur Wellwood, executive director, at 1426 Devine street until October 18.

This project will contain 236 units and is designed to reach the low-income group of an average of \$12 per week.
