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How many people currently hold a valid SC Real Estate license?

47,129 licensees as of November 9th.

- How many people from before the law went into effect currently hold a valid license?
We cannot determine that information. However, there were 42,670 licensees on 5/20/15 which was around the time a contract was awarded to begin background checks. The contract had to be awarded through a competitive bid due to state procurement code requirements.
- Of those who received a license before the law went into effect, how many have been convicted of a felony?
We cannot determine that information. It was based upon self reporting of the applicant, and every application and supporting documentation would have to be reviewed individually.
- Of those who have been convicted of a felony, have their backgrounds - other than their explanation sent in with their application - been reviewed or confirmed with the court of their conviction?
