This letter is to make a formal complaint against Coral Resort. In April 2013, I attended a Coral Resort sales meeting and was sold a fraudulent contract. I was told my weeks would convert to a point system and I would ultimately receive more timeshare weeks per year. About 30 days later RCI contacted me to advise that my weeks would not convert. Also, the sales manager NEVER mentioned or showed me anywhere monthly dues of \$112.00 per month were payable up front for 3 years. What a Scam!

In my research, I have found over a 1000 complaints against this company and cannot understand why these predators have not been stopped! A key point in this fraud scheme is the fact that Coral Resort had not paid state registration fees since 2008 and this alone **nullifies my contract**. They had no proper authority to be selling timeshares, so this alone makes me eligible to receive my \$2500. in full, my credit report repaired and **NO** more contact from Coral Resort.
