Your correspondence to Governor Haley regarding your concerns with the Department of Corrections has been forwarded to me for a response.

On February 2, the agency changed the inmate disciplinary policy regarding the assignment to disciplinary detention (solitary confinement). The new policy means offenses that could have resulted in years in disciplinary detention now have a cap of 60 days. This new disciplinary policy allows inmates to earn back privileges with good behavior. Also, some inmates will remain in disciplinary detention until they no longer pose a threat to staff or other inmates.
