Ford has asked that I send you the latest/greatest Estonia Agreement.

Other than some minor wordsmithing by the Estonia folks, the main changes are to reflect that SCRA is no longer in the picture and that the College of Charleston may step in and we have eliminated the provision that would require each party to notify the other when it's internal procedures necessary for the agreement to become effective were complete. (We never needed this.)

Given recent changes associated with SCRA, the Agreement will not be executed tonight, but instead sometime in April at a ceremony here or in Charleston.
