## **Traumatic Brain Injury Program Moving to ACL**

Today, the Department of Health and Human Services announced that the administration of the [Traumatic Brain Injury \(TBI\) Program](#) is being transferred from the Health Resources and Services Administration (HRSA) to ACL, effective October 1, 2015. The TBI Program, which includes two components, will join ACL's [Administration on Disabilities](#). The State Implementation Program, which provides funding to develop or enhance community-based services to those at risk for or impacted by TBI, will join the [Independent Living Administration](#). The Protection and Advocacy Grants Program, which provides training, advocacy, legal consultation to individuals with TBI will join the [Administration on Intellectual and Developmental Disabilities](#).

HRSA and ACL are working closely to ensure a smooth transition of the program. All current program and grant operations will continue to be administered by HRSA until the current grant cycle has ended.
