**Subject:** EMD Update - Possible Tropical Depression/Storm

The NHC is now predicting a 90% chance of 91L developing today or tomorrow into a tropical depression or maybe even tropical storm Bonnie.

Effects on SC – The entire coast of SC is fair game for 2-5 inches rain and gusty winds Sunday and Monday. Localized beach erosion and rip currents are also possible. An Air Force recon aircraft will fly through the storm this afternoon providing better data and analysis.

Counties – EMD checked in with coastal counties yesterday and will again today. All reported they were monitoring the storm and making preparations for a rainy weekend. The Horry County EOC still plans to be active for Bikefest. SEOC stand-by roster was developed to ensure adequate coverage should the need arise and state agency liaisons/ESF staff have been notified.
