The State Budget and Control Board met in the Governor's Office at 12:45 P. M. on Wednesday, April 27, 1960. All members of the Board were present.

Governor Hollings stated the purpose of the meeting was to consider assignment of a room on first floor of the State House, now being used by the House of Representatives, to the Secretary of State for use of the Securities Division of his Department. The Speaker of the House had expressed opposition to releasing the room.

After some discussion of the matter, during which Mr. Bates expressed himself as believing that the Board should not oppose the House of Representatives in the matter, Senator Brown moved that the room be assigned to the Secretary of State.

Mr. Rhodes seconded the motion of Mr. Brown.

On the vote being taken, four members voted for the motion and one against it.

The Secretary was directed to advise the Director of Sinking Funds and Property of the Board's action, and to instruct him to effect the assignment.

The Board then adjourned.
