Dear Patient,

Thank you for choosing Palmetto Health for your care. It is our goal to make your stay as pleasant as possible. If at any time you have questions about the care you are receiving, please contact your nurse. If you wish for your nurse to contact your physician, a call will be placed to that physician or to the physician who is covering your care that day. The nurse also, if requested, will provide a telephone number for your physician and can assist you with making a phone call if you so desire.

The physician who is admitting you to the hospital is called your attending physician. Your attending physician may have a partner or other physician see you on his or her days off. While you are in the hospital your attending physician may ask another type of physician to help with your care. If you do not understand why another physician is seeing you, please ask your nurse or physician to explain.

Palmetto Health participates in teaching physicians. Licensed physicians receiving further education, called residents, are being trained in our facilities. One or more residents may participate in your care while you are in the hospital. At some of our Palmetto Health facilities, residents also may help make decisions about your care or treatment and may perform or assist in procedures. Other clinical trainees within Palmetto Health include (but are not limited to) nursing students, medical students, physical therapy students, radiology technologist students, sonography technologist students, respiratory therapy students, chaplaincy students and social work students. Residents and other trainees are under the supervision of a properly appointed and hospital approved person who is directly responsible for the resident or student.

You, as our patient, have the right to know who is involved in your care, treatment decisions or surgical procedures. Every caregiver at Palmetto Health, including physicians and each person in training will be wearing an identification badge clearly stating his or her name, department and job or title.

An Application for Involuntary Emergency Hospitalization for Mental Illness was filed on the 19th day of August, 2015 regarding GLOVETTA L. RICHBERG, who currently resides at 2025 MAIN STREET (HOMELESS), COLUMBIA, SC. GLOVETTA L. RICHBERG is represented today by Carlton Bagby, Court-appointed attorney and Guardian ad Litem. Present at the hearing were GLOVETTA L. RICHBERG; Carlton Bagby; Dr. Aleta Marie McGough; Andrea Gantt, MSW.

Based on the documents before the court and the testimony presented at the hearing, I find by clear and convincing evidence that GLOVETTA L. RICHBERG is mentally ill and lacks sufficient insight or capacity to make reasonable decisions with respect to treatment and/or is a danger to herself or others and is in need of involuntary treatment.

THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

GLOVETTA L. RICHBERG shall be committed to Palmetto Richland Springs for further inpatient care and treatment as provided in S.C. Code Ann. §44-17-580 and remain there until stable for discharge.

Upon discharge from Palmetto Richland Springs, GLOVETTA L. RICHBERG must undergo an outpatient treatment program at the Columbia Area Mental Health Center (CAMHC) or a local mental health facility in his/her county of residence for a period no less than 12 months.

GLOVETTA L. RICHBERG must comply with taking all medications as prescribed.

GLOVETTA L. RICHBERG must comply with all appointments as scheduled. Furthermore, GLOVETTA L. RICHBERG is responsible for notifying the treating facility if any appointments cannot be attended as scheduled and is responsible for rescheduling the appointment.

GLOVETTA L. RICHBERG is incapable of caring for herself pursuant to S.C. Code Ann. §44-17-810, and pursuant to the discretion of the mental health treatment team, must reside in a structured living environment, such as a Community Residential Care Facility (CRCF) as defined in §40-35-20 for a period not to exceed 12 months.

A Review Hearing may be held in this matter if requested. If scheduled, notification will be sent to all necessary parties.

This Court shall retain jurisdiction over GLOVETTA L. RICHBERG to insure compliance with this Order, pursuant to S.C. Code Ann. §44-17-580. If GLOVETTA L. RICHBERG does not comply with any portion of this Order, an Affidavit of Noncompliance and Request for Supplemental Hearing will be filed with the Richland County Probate Court and GLOVETTA L. RICHBERG will be required to attend a hearing to show cause as to the reason(s) for the noncompliance.

Pursuant to the S.C. Code Ann. §23-31-1030 and §44-22-100 GLOVETTA L. RICHBERG is prohibited from purchasing and possessing firearms and ammunition and will be reported to SLED for this purpose.

6. Illness (mental, emotional, or physical)

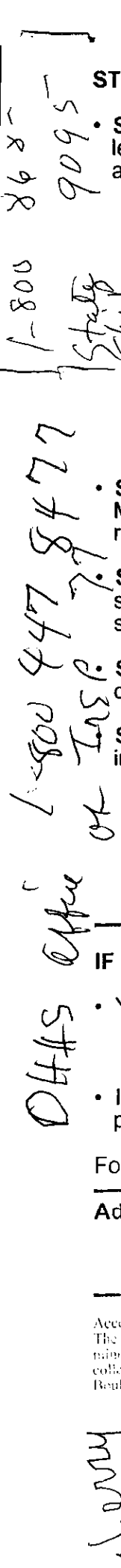

What are some of the physical cues that give us information when are stressed:

1. Breathing problems — ✓
2. Chest pain or heartburn ✓
3. Gastro-intestinal problems
4. Sweaty, trembling, or cold hands (body)
5. Headaches, backaches, or stiff neck or shoulders (holding too tightly) ✓
6. Heart palpitations ✓
7. Sleeping problems (too much or too little), feeling tired ✓
