I hope you're well. It's Bret Baier from Fox. I wanted to extend an invitation to Governor Haley and hope she will consider it.

I am on the executive committee for the Gridiron Club. In that capacity, I would like to formally invite Governor Haley to be the Republican speaker that night.

It is 131th anniversary Gridiron Club and Foundation Dinner on Saturday night, March 5, 2016. I think she would find it an interesting and enjoyable experience.

As you may know, the Gridiron Club is regarded, at least by its members, as Washington's most prestigious journalistic organization. It's composed of 65 Washington-based reporters and columnists from print and broadcast news organizations and has existed since 1885 for the purpose of sponsoring this dinner, featuring skits spoofing the political scene, including the press. The dinner will begin promptly at 7 p.m., with cocktails starting at 5:30 p.m. By eliminating one course and promising to start on time, we have been able in recent years to end the dinner before 10:30 p.m. and we will do so again this year.

It is a white tie event and the biggest names in Washington, in business, and in journalism are in the room that night.
