Background from David. The relevant language from proviso 117.56 is "unallocated funds from established state accounts may be used as the state share in any federally declared disaster." According to David's memo, this is the contingency reserve fund and those housed in an established account but that haven't been appropriated for a particular purpose by the Legislature. You were going to ask Josh and David to identify the balance in the contingency reserve fund and other funds that fit within this provision. I think Josh is already working on this.
