SEA GRANT CONSORTIUM - POSITION ABOVE NUMBER AUTHORIZED - The Board members polled approved a Sea Grant Consortium request to exceed its authorized number of positions by one by establishing one 100% federally-funded Research Specialist II, grade 29, position, with the following condition as approved by the Joint Appropriations Review Committee and the Joint Legislative Committee on Personal Service Financing and Budgeting: "...that the Sea Grant Consortium be allowed to exceed their authorized ceiling by one employee for the period of December 15, 1980, to December 14, 1981, only, and further, that the current attached contract line 32 be amended to clarify the condition that the employee upon return to the S.C. Sea Grant Consortium will not be placed on state appropriated fund payroll."

SUBJECT: S.C. Sea Grant Consortium, Intergovernmental
Personnel Act Grant

The Joint Appropriations Legislative Review Committee at their meeting on December 16, 1980, approved the attached program with the condition that the request for one new position be forwarded to the Joint Committee on Personal Services, Financing, and Budgeting with the following conditions:

"It is recommended that the program be approved and that the Sea Grant Consortium be allowed to exceed their authorized ceiling by one employee for the period of December 15, 1980, to December 14, 1981, only, and further, that the current attached contract line 32 be amended to clarify the condition that the employee upon return to the S.C. Sea Grant Consortium will not be placed on state appropriated fund payroll."

It is requested that the Joint Personal Services Committee consider this request at their next meeting and provide a copy of their decision to the Finance Division for further Budget and Control Board action under Section 5 of South Carolina Act 651.
