WHEREAS, last year, *Rotary Has Heart* raised donations of food and funds for Harvest Hope and packed hundreds of emergency hunger relief boxes through volunteer work at Harvest Hope's facilities; and

WHEREAS, now is the time to partner again for 2015 to feed hungry families and help struggling South Carolinians.
