Latta Producers, Lotta Praise ---at SC Pork Conference

Brothers, Ryan and Renee Coleman, of Latta, SC, were front and center stage recently at the South Carolina Pork Conference in Myrtle Beach. The siblings were presented the Producer of the Year Award, an award presented annually to a South Carolina pork producer (or, in this case, producers) who excel in the use of new technology and production procedures.

Ryan and Renee have been in the business of farming all their lives. Ryan is 22-years-old and single. Renee is 42 and the single parent of two daughters. The brothers grew up on the family tobacco farm---land that has been carefully tended by the Coleman family since before the Civil War.

Renee helped his father run a 300-head sow farrow to finish operation until 1985. Brother Rhett built the family's first farm with Carroll's Foods, Inc, in 1994. Both Ryan and Renee helped out with the operation of this nine house finishing farm. In 1999, the two brothers built their own five house finishing site.

With the advent of the Internet and the growing number of computers on farms and in homes, dot com enterprises are on the rise. Many Internet businesses strive to provide the public with shortcuts to buying, selling and accessing information.

Indicators from Goldman Sachs, a global investment banking and securities firm, predict that by 2004, \$124 billion worth of agricultural commerce will be handled over the Internet. With this in mind, several SC-based agricultural sites have emerged. Farmsaver.com, owned by a Summerton-based company, as well as QuickFarm.com, a Charleston-based company, are two Internet businesses in the state attempting to support the agricultural community through cyberspace technology.

Founded by Jim Thigpen of Summerton and other local agribusiness men, Farmsaver.com supplies farmers with quality agricultural chemicals at competitive prices. The site offers significant savings for agricultural chemicals. The company owns the EPA registrations and manufactures products with efficient expense-to-revenue ratios. Everyone gets the same pricing, because the savings are passed down to the consumer. The nation's cotton growers saved over \$10 million with Farmsaver.com while apple and pear growers saved another \$1 million, according to the web site.

Farmsaver.com formulates and produces their own products using a variety of manufacturers. All active ingredients in the chemicals are verified with the EPA's standards for a technical ingredient and then imported into Farmsaver.com's products and packaged according to required methods. Currently, the site has three products, Mepiquat Chloride Plant Growth Regulator, Acephate 90SP, and Acephate 75P. These chemicals work the same as comparable brand products, and all contents are on the label. Within the first quarter of 2001 Farmsaver.com hopes to introduce new products and will only advertise them when they are registered.

This site sells direct to farmers and saves them money by testing, registering, manufacturing and selling products to producers. Farmsaver.com catches chemicals when their patents expire and then registers the product to sell direct to farmers. It is an online, direct-to-farm way of ordering chemicals.

QuickFarm.com caters to the professional farmer by providing a Web service center, online farm input procurement, and a center where farmers can streamline their operations and reduce costs. This site was created in 1999 allowing farmers to negotiate prices on business related supplies, therefore reducing bottom lines. The creators, Kirkman Finlay III, a SC farmer, and Mason Pope, an exchange specialist and former VP of a global bank, sought to create a site with a farmer-centric approach; one that provides essential agricultural information, such as weather, future quotes, and USDA research, and also contains financial tools such as accounting software. Currently, 10,000 farmers across the state and nation are registered with the site.

The site is like a "virtual administrator", assisting with various tasks such as paying bills, gathering market reports, and locating the best prices for products. QuickFarm.com focuses on four crops, corn, cotton, wheat and soybeans, and helps find suppliers for farm chemicals, especially herbicides and pesticides, as well as connecting online buyers with names of sellers of seed.

Giving farmers a bountiful access to prices, data and technology is not the only function of QuickFarm.com. So you say you don't have a computer? Well, QuickFarm.com can help with that too! Through their site in cooperation with micronpc.com, farmers can learn about computer terminology, prices for computers and how to buy a computer based on what they need in a system.

Because the population depends on us for food, clothing, and shelter, we in the business of farming must grasp whatever technology makes us more efficient. Even though the average age of a farmer is 56-years-old, "it's never too late to teach an old dog new tricks," as they say. And, for many farmers to save time and money, dot coms may be the way!
