- About 250 attendees have registered – it’s a mix of IT leaders from the public and private sectors (corporate, K-12 and higher education, county/local government, etc). Full list below.

BACKGROUND:

- IT-oLogy’s “Summit on Information Technology” is a day-long event “to inform and educate attendees about what’s currently being done across the state” in the IT arena. It’s also billed as a networking event for “IT, education, and policy leaders” in South Carolina.
- The Department of Commerce and the SC Chamber of Commerce are co-sponsors of the Summit.
- All attendees will be together in the morning. During the afternoon, they’ll break up into four

- separate working groups based upon their “industry verticals” (banking, healthcare, professional services, and entrepreneurship/innovation). Nick Patel will chair the healthcare panel.
- The Summit’s major themes are how IT impacts economic development, and what we’re doing to educate SC’s workforce and to be competitive regionally and nationally.

TALKING POINTS:

- First, I’m excited to be here with you today to talk about the importance of technology in education, in the workplace, and in our lives. Thanks so much to the folks at IT-oLogy for putting this Summit together, and to the Department of Commerce and the SC Chamber of Commerce for their support of this event.
- Since Day 1 as Governor, I have been focused on jobs – and we’ve made real progress. The unemployment rate is now down to 5.5%, which is half of what it was when I came into office.
- High-tech jobs are an important part of that renaissance. More than 62,000 South Carolinians work in the technology industry now, earning an average wage of about \$60,000 per year. These are the kinds of high-quality jobs that will sustain families for years to come.
- The Palmetto State is on the move. In a recent study, South Carolina had the 2nd highest rate of high-tech job growth of any state. Columbia and Charleston were both on the list of “Top 5” metro areas for high-tech job growth.
- We’re proud of these accomplishments, but we’re not going to stop there, because we know that we can only grow and attract high-quality jobs like these if we have a skilled workforce that’s ready to the needs of business.
- That’s why my budget this year contained nearly \$30 million in additional funding for K-12 educational technology. That money can be used to improve broadband service to our schools, to build or improve wireless networking in those facilities, or to purchase equipment – like laptops and tablets – for 1:1 computing initiatives.
- I also recommended \$4 million to train teachers on how to get the most out of that investment, in order to acclimate students to technology and improve student performance.
- In addition to all this, I proposed an unprecedented \$12 million investment in digital instructional materials because technology isn’t just changing what we teach, but how we teach it.
- All of these recommendations are part of a comprehensive education reform package that is designed to prepare South Carolina not just to be part of the new knowledge economy, but to lead it.
- Leading the way means creating a culture of innovation – in education, in the workplace, and even in our government. As you meet today to share ideas, I hope you will develop a set of specific, actionable recommendations that I can take back across the street and put to use. We can use a few good ideas over there.
- Thanks again for coming together today and helping us move South Carolina forward.
