Dear Mr. Godfrey,

I did forward the information regarding the SC Commission for Minority Affairs to Mr. Glaccum as instructed; which I assume he is digesting my input before contacting me with his position. Related to the same cause, I am sitting on some conceivably idea rich solutions that I would like to explore their potential value.

I am suggesting that the governor can start a mutually beneficial conversation that ranges from grassroots local to national, one that is even global, originating from her own merits to extend the list of measurable accomplishments in South Carolina.
