As we discussed, based on the recent success of the hosting consultants at the football games, I wanted to see if I could create something similar using a USC Baseball game. The key to this would be the Governor's schedule and willingness to host a lunch. I would target 4 - 6 consultants for this event.

Below is a very rough outline of a schedule which flows very similarly to the recent events held during the Clemson football weekend. It gives USC a chance to talk about the school as well as provide a unique South Carolina experience.
