## **Gov. Nikki Haley Discusses Ethics Reform**

**COLUMBIA, S.C.** – Governor Nikki Haley today urged lawmakers to make ethics reform a priority in the upcoming legislative session - emphasizing the need for income disclosure requirements, independent investigations into elected officials and eliminating conflicts of interest in the General Assembly.

Gov. Nikki Haley said, "I say this with great optimism because I do believe there is willingness in the House and Senate... Please make sure that we do not go home this session without income disclosures from our legislators, without independent investigators looking into those legislators, and without making sure that we remove those conflicts of interest that we're seeing right now. If we do that, taxpayers can celebrate and legislators can relax because they will know exactly what is right and

wrong.”
