Katherine and David,

The South Carolina Forestry Association respectfully requests for Governor Haley to sign Senate Bill 868. The legislation balances private property rights and economic development. A companion bill Senate Bill 1065 establishes a study committee to review eminent domain laws involving petroleum pipelines.

Senate Bill 868 prohibits petroleum pipelines companies from using eminent domain until June 30, 2019. This provides the study committee with an opportunity to review other state statutes dealing with eminent domain for petroleum pipelines and make recommendations to the General Assembly regarding this issue.
