- *Darlington Raceway is an important component of South Carolina's sports, entertainment and tourism industry – with an economic impact of \$54 million annually, over 100,000 in attendance each year, and over 874 permanent jobs for South Carolina residents result directly or indirectly from the operations of Darlington Raceway.*
- *We couldn't do this without our partner Bojangles! A Big Thank You to Bojangles!! Bojangles is an integral part of the future of Darlington Raceway -- signing a new five year extension with the historic racing facility – (this will be the first year of the 5 year contract / 2015 – 2019)*
