I have gotten no help from any of those people, and their bosses is Mr. The Call, and I have written Mr. The Call and I have written Brian Sterling. I've gotten no response. You are all in my right. I will and I will continue to write because it is my right. I will forward a copy of this to my state representative, and to the medical WITS for help. I've done nothing wrong. If I would have done some wrong I would have been charged, so I'm asking your office to look into this matter. Grievance does nothing for the inmates here. I'm not an inmate that doesn't have a family that loves me. All I need to do is talk my family what is going on and they will be all over it. I will fight for my right, because it is my right. I'm writing your office for help on an incident that happened on 6-12-15. When I was sitting down and was hit from behind, by another inmate. I was left with a fracture cheek bone and rupture eye socket.

I was talking to medical and transferred to Cheyenne hospital, because of the injury. I was also transferred to McCleod hospital. McCleod doctors stated that I needed to see a bone specialist, and was transferred to Stokes Eye doctor. Do to the swelling on the eye, Stokes doctor recommend that I come back that Monday.

The prison waiting four days to transferred me to S.C.D.C. doctor. Immediately, I know my eye wasn't in the interest of the doctor. To this day, I still don't know if the inmate who stuck me, doesn't change are not. To this day, I've still not seen a Bone specialist for my face.

After several more visited to S.C.D.C. eye doctor, confirmed that my eye are still having problems. He stated, "I need lanted glasses for light. To this day, S.C.D.C. still have not provided me those glasses. I've spoke to the Warden, Major and I've wrote the Director of S.C.D.C. about this matter, S.C.D.C., is more like trying to minimize my injured and shift the blame. By telling me my family have to

provided these glasses. I'm house by S.C.D.C., it's not  
my family responsibility.

"If it was your love one, wouldn't you'd love for them  
to've proper medical treatment?" "I committed a crime, I was  
punished in the court of Law. I shouldn't be punished by  
the lack of medical care.
