Amend the bill further, as and if amended, Part IA, Section 91B, LEG. DEPT - HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES, page 265, line 11,

by:

COLUMN 7 COLUMN 8

/ STRIKING: 11,990,627 11,990,627

and

INSERTING: 10,502,627 10,502,627/

Amend the bill further, as and if amended, Part IB, Section 91, LEGISLATIVE DEPARTMENT, page 487, by striking proviso 91.13 and inserting:

/ 91.13.(LEG: In-District Compensation) All members of the General Assembly shall receive an in-district compensation of \$1,000 per month. /

Renumber sections to conform.

Amend sections, totals and title to conform.
