A wooden frame structure, with a side-gabled roofline that has visible rafter tails along the eaves; central door is located beneath a partial-width, gabled front porch that is supported by simple square posts. There is a single, six-over-six, double-hung, wooden sash window on either side of the front door. Each gable end has two single six-over-six, double-hung, wooden sash windows, with the windows on the south elevation flanking a concrete block exterior chimney; there is brick interior chimney visible above the roof ridge north of center.
