Hello,

I am currently staying at the Calhoun Falls state park. We have been here for one week and have a few days left to stay. My family is occupying 4 campsites (sites 3-6) with 8 adults, 3 children and 5 pets. We have been very upset with the lack respect shown by the youth staying in the park. On numerous occasions this week, we have come to a road block due to older children loitering on bikes and golf carts. They give very little room for our cars to pass by and I feel very unsafe passing them so close in the road, though they do not make any effort to move. Our part of the campground does not seem to have a campsite belonging to any of these kids though they park on their bikes in the road near our campers and talk very loudly, disrespectfully, and often using profanity with each other. When these children ride their golf carts through the campground, they drive much faster than what is allowed and can't possibly be old enough to legally drive.

Normally, we enjoy our stay at Calhoun Falls but this has been quite an un-enjoyable visit. I am afraid to let my children play outside our camper for fear of them being hit by a speeding golf cart. I also fear walking around the park with my children and pets for the same reason. I know this is spring break but those of us that respect the rules should not have to suffer. I hope a ranger will decide to stop some of this bothersome behaviour soon. We have seen rangers pass through the campground though they never seem to stop these kids.
