- The May 15, 2013 "First Supplemental and Amending Petition for Declaratory Judgment, Writ of Mandamus, and Damages" filed by Petitioner Justin L. Winch; and
- May 22, 2013 "Exception of No Cause or Right of Action", filed by Defendants Stephen Perry, President and CEO of the New Orleans Convention and Visitors Bureau; Steve Moeller, Vice President of the New Orleans Convention and Visitors Bureau; and Kelly Schulz, Vice President of Communication and Public Relations of the New Orleans Convention and Visitors Bureau (collectively, "NOCVB");


Present were Justin L. Winch, *pro se*; and Alysson L. Mills, counsel for the NOCVB.

The Court, having reviewed the parties' memoranda, the evidence, and the law, hereby **ORDERS, ADJUDGES AND DECREES** that the NOCVB's Exception of No Cause or Right of Action shall be **DENIED**;


IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that Plaintiff's request for Declaratory Judgment is **GRANTED** and the Court Declares that the New Orleans Convention Visitors Bureau ("NOCVB") is subject to the Public Records Law,

La. R.S. 44:1 *et seq.*, and all applicable requirements with respect thereto, to the extent the requested records reflect expenditure of public funds, and that such documents are 'public records' under the Act. Furthermore, the NOCVB shall produce all such documents as required by the law, La. R.S. 44:1 *et seq* and described herein.
