Subject: Background on Governor's schedule

Alex - These are not being sent as talking points but merely as background information that the Secretary may find useful. We pulled this data from the Governor's schedule, which your office may also choose to verify. If it's helpful, we will also send you a redacted and an unredacted copy of the Governor's schedule for reference. The schedule will be finalized for dissemination pending your office's approval of the economic development redactions.

Governor Haley attended 51* meetings or events:

...in nine days (average of 5.7 events/day, including a Saturday & a Sunday);

...in six cities (average of 8.5 events/city).

- 65% economic development related (33/51)
- 22% workforce and higher-education related (11/51)
- 13% government related (7/51)

Meetings: Governor Haley held 15 working meetings regarding current Commerce projects or current Commerce prospects, which accounts for 45% of her economic development meetings and events. (This number does not include the unknown number of "push-and-pull" meetings or "meet-and-greets" with potential prospects done before or after an event.)

Events: Governor Haley spoke at 15 events that reached more than 5,000 people, including more than 1,400 members of industry and more than 3,600 higher education students or officials.

Note on Press: Governor Haley held three media availabilities and had one televised interview, generating local, national, and international news for South Carolina.

*This number does not include the visit to the Golden Temple, two SC Delegation dinners, and four press events (one televised interview and three media availabilities).
