This month, in honor of the season, we celebrate Campbell's Covered Bridge – the last remaining covered bridge in [South Carolina](#). It was built in 1909 and is located in [Greenville County](#) community of Gowensville. One of four covered bridges built in northeastern Greenville County in the early 20th century, this one was named for Lafayette Campbell, the owner of a nearby grist mill who allowed his land to be used for the bridge's construction.
