#### Description/Significant Features:

The single story, frame church building (1461.00) has a front-gabled roofline with deep cornice returns, with a small square steeple along the ridge. The front elevation is dominated by a low-pitched, gabled portico, which is enclosed, with a shed-roofed hood supported by simple brackets shading the central double doorway. In the gable end of the main church building is a rectangular attic vent. Along the side elevations, there are four single one-over-one, double-hung, vinyl sash windows. The exterior of the main church building is covered with wooden weatherboard siding, while the enclosed portico has a vinyl siding exterior; the roof is composition shingles.
