the national title, which is given each year at the Expo held in Moultrie, Ga.

McIntyre farms more than 1,000 acres on two farms—one in Marion and one in Rowland, N.C., in addition to working his full-time job as a lead operator at Smurfit Stone paper mill near Marion. He grows corn, wheat, soybeans, tobacco, oats, rye, hay and timber and has a cow-calf operation and a swine farrowing-to-finish operation. He says his diversity and the fact that he has one farm 20 miles from the other have kept him in the farming business. He says having two separate farms is a safeguard, because if one experiences a drought or bad weather, the other is thriving, if he's lucky.

So how does he work two farms and keep another full-time job? His answer is shift-work and vacations. Odd hours at the paper mill allow McIntyre to tend to his farm, and he schedules his vacations around planting and harvesting times. He has one hired employee, and his wife and son—one of three children who still live at home—also help him with the farm.

McIntyre said weather and farm prices are so unpredictable, it's difficult today for farmers to get by without having another steady job.

"That's the way you have to do farming today," he said. "Farming is tough but it's a good way of life, and you've got to love it to do it."

Though the job is tough, McIntyre said winning S.C.'s Farmer of the Year is a great way to be thanked for his work.

"I think it's a big honor," he said. "Anybody would be proud."

Each state winner competed to represent their region for Farmer of the Year, and each regional winner will then compete for the national title. State winners received \$1,500 cash from Swisher International. The Southeastern Farmer of the Year will win \$12,500 cash from Swisher. The National Farmer of the Year will also receive one-year's use of a Massey Ferguson 4200 series tractor from AGCO and one year's supply of clothing from Williamson-Dickie Company.

The Lancaster/Sunbelt Expo will be held in Moultrie, Ga., on Oct. 19-21.

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Commissioner's Column

Fall for pork and pumpkins

Fall is finally here. The leaves have turned, the air's a little crispier, and pumpkins are ready for Halloween. But, October is also set aside as the month in which we celebrate pork—"the other white meat."

Promotions during National Pork Month include a school lunch menu project, environmental educational programs, and even Focus on Family Values, a promotional program geared at bringing families together for dinner—a dinner which hopefully will include pork.

In recognition of Pork Month, the National Pork Producers Council (NPPC) has launched an aggressive campaign aimed at both promoting pork as a healthy, heart-friendly food and getting families together to enjoy the popular meat.

As a part of NPPC's Focus on Family Values program, they are offering a certificate for a free family portrait at JCPenny studios until Dec. 31—a great gift. To have your family's picture taken, you need proof of a 2-pound purchase of fresh pork at your local grocery store and the photo certificate, which can be found on the Internet at www.nppc.org.

In addition to the free family portraits national campaign, South Carolina's pork industry has developed the Governor's Cup Culinary Competition. The contest teams up chefs and school food service personnel across the state who create school lunch menus that are not only good for children, but also include foods that children will eat. The competition was held at the Myrtle Beach Convention Center on Oct. 16. For the contest, each team prepared a meal with a pork dish as the main entree. Each lunch also had to include servings of milk, bread, fruits and vegetables for a well-balanced meal.

First-place winners received the Governor's Cup and \$1,000, second-place winners received \$750, and third-place winners received \$250. But, the school children are winners, too. A panel of children tasted the foods for each team to make sure that the menu was appealing to their senses.

In addition to the Governor's Cup Culinary Competition, the state's pork producers have scheduled a planning meeting in November to implement the On-Farm Odor/Environmental Assistance and the Odor Solutions Initiative programs here in the state. The programs target on-farm environmental and odor issues and provide expert advice on appropriate engineering, biological, or management solutions for pork livestock operations. Neutral third-party inspectors who assess pork operations will execute the On-Farm program. On a similar level, the Odor Solutions Initiative is a project to research and evaluate biological, chemical, mechanical, nutritional and management technologies that abate or eliminate farm-related odor. The truth is that our hog farmers not only in South Carolina but throughout the nation have had a really tough year. Prices for hogs have been extremely low. At the same time, the price in the grocery store is just right for selecting your favorite cut to go with your fall pumpkin pie.

Remember, as Halloween approaches, it's time for adults and children to apply their creative talents to pumpkin carving and painting. Jack-o'-lanterns already brighten my neighbors' front yards and porches, but there are still plenty of South Carolina quality pumpkins to buy. Pumpkins aren't just for decorating; they can be used in anything from soups to breads and pies. And because they're rich in beta-carotene, dietary fiber, and tons of vitamin A, pumpkins are a very healthy food.

So, take a break from raking the leaves. Load up the entire family for a visit to one of the three state farmers markets in Columbia, Greenville, and Florence, or check out your nearest U-pick operation

Well-Dressed Pork

Ingredients: Filling — 1 1/2 lbs. boneless pork chops, cut in 3/4-in. cubes; 1 cup chopped broccoli; 2 cups sliced carrots; 2 tablespoons vegetable oil; 1/3 cup finely chopped green onions; 2 cloves garlic, finely chopped; 1 1/2 cup white sauce; 5 1/2 cups bow tie pasta, cooked; 1/3 cup grated Parmesan cheese; 2 large tomatoes, diced; 2 tablespoons chopped fresh parsley; salt and black pepper to taste.

Directions: Place broccoli and carrots in medium saucepan; add about 1 in. water. Cook over medium-high heat until tender, drain and set aside. Heat oil in large skillet over medium-high heat until hot; add pork and garlic. Cook 5-10 mintues or until pork is no longer pink. Add green onions and sauté for 1 minute. Prepare white sauce. Combine pasta, pork mixture, vegetables and white sauce in large casserole dish. Top with Parmesan cheese, tomatoes, parsley, salt and pepper. Toss and serve. 8 servings.

White sauce: 2 tablespoons butter, 2 cups milk, 2 tablespoons flour, 1/4 cup Parmesan cheese.
