Mr. Poore called the meeting to order and Mr. Gerrard gave the invocation.

On the motion of Mr. Rhodes, seconded by Mr. Wright, Council voted unanimously to approve the minutes of the March 21, 1978 meeting as mailed.

Mr. Robert B. King read to Council a letter from the Emergency Medical Services Commission recommending that an advanced life support paramedic system be established through the Anderson County rescue squads. Council accepted the recommendation as information.

On the motion of Mr. Rhodes, seconded by Mr. Hooper, Council voted unanimously to recommend that Mr. Joel Jones be appointed to the EMS Council.

Mrs. Ardy Armen requested that the roads in Stonewall Woods Subdivision be resurfaced. Council accepted her request as information.

Mr. John Miller, Vice-President of Anderson Memorial Hospital, presented to Council an Assistance Agreement for hospital facilities revenue bonds not to exceed thirty-two million dollars (\$32,000,000). On the motion of Mr. Wright, seconded by Mr. Hooper, Council voted unanimously to enter into assistance agreement with Anderson Memorial Hospital.

On the motion of Mr. Wright, seconded by Mr. Hooper, Council voted unanimously to adopt on first (1st) reading Ordinance # 26 authorizing thirty-two million dollars (\$32,000,000) in hospital facilities revenue bonds (Anderson Memorial Hospital Project).

Mr. Robert P. Lusk read Ordinance # 26. On the motion of Mr. Hooper, seconded by Mr. Bratcher, Council voted unanimously to adopt on first (1st) reading Ordinance # 26 (\$32,000,000 Hospital Facilities Revenue Bonds - Anderson Memorial Hospital Project).

On the motion of Mr. Hooper, seconded by Mr. Gerrard, Council voted unanimously to transfer funds from Account # 460 (Emergency Medical Services) Object # 02 (Salaries and Wages) to install a direct telephone line from the Emergency Medical Services Central Dispatch office to Anderson Memorial Hospital emergency room.

On the motion of Mr. Rhodes, seconded by Mr. Bratcher, Council voted unanimously to authorize Mr. Robert B. King to transfer two (2) Civil Defense vehicles to the Supervisor's office.

On the motion of Mr. Wright, seconded by Mr. Bratcher, Council voted unanimously to adopt Resolution # 47 authorizing Mr. Hugh Agnew to remove the Judge's chair in the Circuit Judge's Office which was formerly used by the Honorable E. Harry Agnew and to replace it with a new Judge's chair equivalent in all respects to the existing chair.

Mrs. Judy Berry came before Council to discuss a Leash Law and Dog Catcher for Anderson County. Mr. Robert P. Lusk advised Mrs. Berry that he is in the process of compiling into

the form of an Ordinance all information that he has obtained concerning this matter, and he hope to have the Ordinance ready by Council's next meeting on April 18, 1978.

On the motion of Mr. Hooper, seconded by Mr. Gerrard, Council voted unanimously to adjourn at 9:58 a.m.
