WHEREAS, through their dedication to the principles of good citizenship, these students serve as positive role models for young people across South Carolina and the nation by making a significant difference in their communities; and

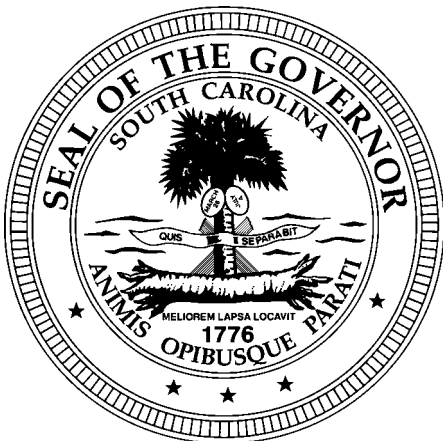
