**WHEREAS**, the Rev. Raymond A. McKinney, a native of Lincoln County, Georgia, was a resident of Tigerville until his death in 1992; and

**WHEREAS**, Rev. McKinney between 1945 and 1969, served as pastor at Union Baptist Church in Laurens County, Harmony Baptist Church in Laurens County, Warrior Creek Baptist Church in Laurens County, Clarendon Baptist Church in Alcolu, Mount Olive Baptist Church in Nichols, and New Holland Baptist Church in Wagener; and

**WHEREAS**, he attended North Greenville College, Furman University, and Southeastern Baptist Theological Seminary, and served on the Board of Trustees of North Greenville College from 1963 to 1967, and on the Board of Trustees for Connie Maxwell Children's Home at Greenwood from 1952 to 1956; and

**WHEREAS**, Rev. McKinney joined North Greenville College in 1967 as Director of Alumni Relations and later became Director of Publicity and Assistant to the President, and

**WHEREAS**, his love and support of North Greenville College are evident in his establishment of the Raymond A. and Ruby MCKinney Endowment Scholarship Fund which he and his dear wife have faithfully supported through the years; and

**WHEREAS**, the Greenville County Legislative Delegation has requested that Road S-23-414 from its intersection with US 25 going east toward Tigerville, to the intersection of Road S-23-253, be named "R. A. McKinney Boulevard; " and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the South Carolina Transportation Commission that Road S-23-414 between US 25 and Road S-23-253 be named the "R. A. McKinney Boulevard."

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that a copy of this resolution be forwarded to north Greenville College , the Town of Tigerville and the Greenville Legislative Delegation.

**RESOLUTION**

**WHEREAS**, Dr M. C. Donnan was born on January 11, 1892, in Greer, South Carolina, the same year that North Greenville Academy was founded; and

**WHEREAS**, after being educated at Spartan Academy in Lyman, South Carolina, he graduated from Furman University in 1924, nd from Southern Baptist Theological Seminary in 1928; and

**WHEREAS**, in 1934, he became president of North Greenville College, and remained in that capacity for 28 years; and

**WHEREAS**, during his tenure as president, and largely as a result of his personal leadership, North Greenville College continued to prosper through years of the Depression and during World War II, as well as the years that followed; and

**WHEREAS**, the Greenville County Legislative Delegation has requested that Road S-23-994 at Tigerville, currently know as Boulevard Avenue, be renamed "Donnan Boulevard" and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the South Carolina Transportation Commission that Road S-23-994 be renamed "Donnan Boulevard" in recognition of Dr. Donnan's life of service to North Greenville College, Greenville County and the State of South Carolina.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that a copy of this resolution be forwarded to North Greenville College, the Town of Tigerville and the Greenville Legislative Delegation.

**SECTION 16:** The Commission passed a motion authorizing the department to continue with the STIP and SHIP programs in accordance with red, yellow and green county formula which has been used in previous years. Commissioner Mack voted against this motion.
