The award-winning Network of Care recently launched a highly innovative new Web site in the area of prisoner reentry.

The [Network of Care for Prisoner Reentry](#) grew from the highly successful Network of Care for Behavioral Health, which is now in 17 states. The Prisoner Reentry Web site, piloted in Philadelphia, was a collaboration between the judges of Philadelphia's First Judicial District; probation staff; the treatment community; consumers, and us.

In essence, the Network of Care greatly enhances the effort to engage a formerly incarcerated person with the treatment community, if the underlying issue is mental illness or addiction. Additionally, we offer a highly advanced compliance and tracking application to help ensure a person referred to treatment actually shows up as referred.
