Advertisement for Bids

The Housing Authority of the City of Columbia, S. C., Arthur R. Wellwood, Executive Director, will receive sealed bids for the construction of the entire Low Rent Housing Project No. S. C. 2-1, Columbia, S. C., until 12:00 o'clock, noon, E.S.T., on Wednesday, the 10th day of October, 1939, at 1426 Devine Street, Columbia, State of South Carolina, at which time and place all bids will be publicly opened and read aloud.

The successful bidder will be required to furnish satisfactory performance and payment bond or bonds.

Attention is called to the fact that not less than the minimum wage rates as set forth in the Specification must be paid on this project.

Proposed forms of contract documents, including plans and specifications, are on file and may be examined at the office of The Housing Authority of the City of Columbia, S. C., at 1426 Devine Street, Columbia, S. C.

Copies of the documents may be obtained by depositing one hundred (\$100.00) dollars with the Housing Authority of the City of Columbia, South Carolina, for each set of documents so obtained. The amount of the deposit will be refunded to each bona fide bidder who returns the plans and documents in good condition within ten (10) days after the opening of bids.

If additional sets of documents are required by the bidders, they shall deposit the same amount for each such additional set of documents as above; however, only \$50.00 of the deposit for each such additional set of documents will be refunded to the bidders if documents are returned in good condition within ten (10) days after the opening of bids.

No refund will be made of any deposit in any case where the person making such deposit fails to submit a bona fide bid.

Deposit for plans and specifications will be in the form of certified check made out to The Housing Authority of the City of Columbia, South Carolina.

The Housing Authority of the City of Columbia, South Carolina, reserves the right to reject any or all bids and to waive any informalities in bidding.

A certified check or bank draft payable to The Housing Authority of the City of Columbia, S. C., U. S. Government Bonds, or a satisfactory bid bond executed by the bidder and a surety company, in an amount equal to Five Per Cent (5%) of the bid, shall be submitted with each bid.

No bid shall be withdrawn for a period of sixty (60) days subsequent to the opening of bids without the consent of The Housing Authority of the City of Columbia, S. C.
