" FREEDOM OF INFORMATION  
ACT  
5 U.S.C

To Whom This May Concern: Sir / madam, Goodmorning or Goodafternoon

I'm writing this correspondence seeking information under THE FREEDOM OF INFORMATION Act see 5 U.S.C. which establish a broad mandate for the disclosure of governmental information by requiring that all material be made public "unless explicitly allowed to be kept Secret by one of the exemptions..... S. Rep. NO. 813 89<sup>th</sup> cong., 1<sup>st</sup> Sess., 10 (1965). The Act requires 'De Novo' agency claims of exemption and it places on the agency the burden of defending its withholding of information. See 5 U.S.C. § 552 (a)(4) (B). Congress made it clear and sought to assure the government would not operate behind [V]eil secrecy, and it narrowly tailored the exemption to the fundamental goal of disclosure.

Furthermore, I'm requesting this office to disclose an Updated record of the South Carolina Department of Correction Officers Code Behavioral and Disciplinary System. More so, Since the Governor vs. Nikki Haley Office has jurisdiction over the penology of the prison system, this record should not in any manner be exempted.
