Subject: Constituent issue - mother in inadequate nursing facility

Good afternoon sir,

It was a pleasure to speak with you and the Lieutenant Governor yesterday. I am writing to inform you of a constituent issue where I believe your office may be able to provide assistance.

The constituent is Marvalyn McLemore who is a resident of Inman, SC. Her mother, who has dementia, was recently placed in a nursing facility in Anderson called The Resting Place which Marvalyn believes is not adequate. She believes the facility is neglecting basic care and attention for her mother. Marvalyn says she has the resources to care for her mother at home but that the nursing facility is uncooperative in allowing a move. In fact, if I understand correctly she was recently prohibited from even seeing her mother because the mother does not want to leave Marvalyn after a visit and becomes agitated.

Marvalyn is trying to get custody and power of attorney for her mother but the courts are not moving quickly and DSS seems to be making the situation worse. She does not know where to turn. She feels DSS is unfairly blaming her for her mother's condition.

The mother's name is Lynda J. Carter. I have her SSN and DOB if that would be helpful. Marvalyn's number is 864-508-9610.
