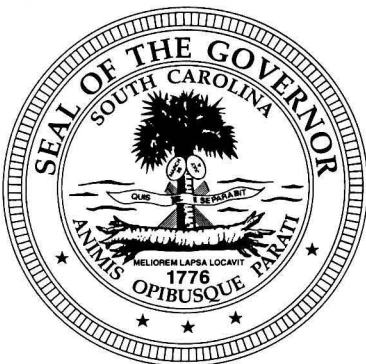
WHEREAS, with cooking teams participating in professional and amateur competitions, the winner of the professional division will qualify for the national invitational championship event; and
