Other:

Circa 1945 factory building of no distinct style or type. This building has undergone a number of additions and alterations, but the historic core is rectangular and one oversized story tall with a front-gabled asphalt roll roof. It is composed of 5-to-1 common bond brick and faces south towards Russell Street. The main elevation features a simple parapet with a brick cap and an inset portion where signage for the Orangeburg Pecan Company is painted. It is accessed via a wood panel barn door with a concrete loading ramp and a single wood panel personnel door with a blind transom. A single wood frame sixover-six double-hung sash window is located to the west of the door and a hyphen with double wood panel and glass doors has been added to connect Resource 0334 with Resource 0334.05 on the eastern side.

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Alterations (including date(s), if known):

The west and rear (south) elevations of the building have been added to multiple times. A shed roofed addition and a hipped addition with brick veneer are located on the west elevation. Further additions to the rear of the building include two concrete block portions with corrugated metal shed roofs and a corrugated metal-clad cupola to house tall equipment. A large 5-to-1 common bond brick portion with an arched asphalt roll roof extends to the rear and east of the building. Resource 0334 is connected to Resource 0334.02 via this rear extension.
