As you are likely aware, due to the failure of Congress to reach a deal on balanced deficit reduction to avoid sequestration, on March 1, 2013, the President was required by law to issue a sequestration order canceling approximately \$85 billion in budgetary resources across the Federal Government for the remainder of the Federal fiscal year. As a result of sequestration, the Department of Energy's overall budget has been reduced by nearly \$1.9 billion for the remainder of the fiscal year. Attached is a letter to Governor Haley from Deputy Secretary Poneman outlining the Department's preliminary analysis on some of the impacts from the spending cuts to the State of South Carolina. Please be aware that this preliminary analysis may change as we seek to manage reductions across the Department's complex.
