As many know, Huntington Beach State Park is a beautiful example of South Carolina's upper coastal environment, featuring oceanfront, dunes, saltmarsh, freshwater pond and maritime forest habitats that support a wide variety of wildlife.

The nature center was an iconic structure that helped interpret this natural beauty and significance. Thousands of visitors came not only to learn more about Huntington Beach, but to find inspiration and make memories.

The SC Department of Parks, Recreation & Tourism is currently assessing the loss of the center from an early-morning fire and will determine short-term as well as long-term goals once that assessment is complete.

Most of the park remains open, including the campground and the south end that includes the historic Atalaya home, park bathhouse, visitor center and trails into the maritime forest. The north end, including a picnic shelter and beach access, and the boardwalk / wildlife observation decks, will re-open once the incident site is secured.

SCPRT will continue to prioritize visitor service and safety, and will return to normal operations as soon as possible.
