Alzheimer's and the 21st Century Cares Act

A bill known as the EUREKA Act ... "Ensuring Useful Research Expenditures is Key for Alzheimer's" ... was introduced with bipartisan support (62 co-sponsors) in the U.S. Senate by Mississippi Senator Roger Wicker in 2015, and in 2016 companion legislation was introduced in the House of Representatives with 37 co-sponsors. This Act was intended to "establish EUREKA Prize Competitions to accelerate discovery and development of disease-modifying, preventive, or curative treatments for Alzheimer's disease and related dementia, to encourage efforts to enhance detection and diagnosis of such diseases, or to enhance the quality and efficiency of care of individuals with such diseases."
