More than \$30 million is being invested in a new Homewood Suites by Hilton Myrtle Beach Oceanfront Resort & Conference Center on Ocean Boulevard near 17th Avenue South in Myrtle Beach. The new development will join the Hampton Inn & Suites Oceanfront Resort next door to become the first dually branded oceanfront resort hotel for Hilton Worldwide.

The new hotel will have 100 guest suites and a 12,500-square-foot, 300-seat conference center. Guests can enjoy an indoor/outdoor pool, water slide, sports court, outdoor kitchen and firepit as well as the amenities of the Hampton Inn, including six additional indoor and outdoor pools and two lazy rivers.

The new Homewood Suites hotel is the first new hotel built in Myrtle Beach since 2009, and is expected to open in the Spring of 2016.
